NOTIFICATION

No. C1/36/2018-TC. *21st March 2018.*

Whereas, Rule 41 of Kerala Motor Vehicle Rule 1989 provides that the drivers of Transport Vehicles shall while on duty, be cleanly dressed in the uniform specified by the Transport Commissioner;

And Whereas, vide Notification published as C/16658/TC/94 dated 20-4-1995 the Transport Commissioner has specified that the drivers of transport vehicles shall wear pants & shirt in khaki cloth & women drivers either a pants & shirt in khaki coat in khaki cloth over their normal dress while driving the auto rickshaws;

And Whereas, the District Auto Rickshaw Drivers Unions Co-ordination Committee, Kochi, vide their letter dated 12-1-2018, requested to change the color/pattern of the uniform for the drivers of autorickshaws plying as

feeder service to Public Transport System of Kochi, mainly, Metro, Stage Carriages and Water Transport with a pattern for consideration;

And Whereas, the Director (Projects) of KMRL, Kochi, vide their letter No. KMRL/UT/07/2018 dated 14-2-2018 has recommended for favourable consideration of the request of District Auto Rickshaw Drivers Unions Co-ordination Committee, Kochi.

And Whereas, the said change in uniform pattern is intended to specially identify the feeder Auto Rickshaw Drivers and to induce a better, safe and secured feeling to the travelling public, especially for women, senior citizen and children and also make the Auto Rickshaw drivers more responsible in terms of driving and exhibiting good behaviour with the passengers.

Now Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred up on the Transport Commissioner of Kerala, under Rule 41 of KMV Rules 1989, hereby prescribe the uniform for the Auto Rickshaw drivers of Kochi Metropolitan area

(GCDA/GIDA Area) while using auto rickshaws for the purpose of feeder service as mentioned above shall wear Black trousers (full) and T-shirt of dark turquoise colour as well as name plate with 'QR' code. That 'QR' code contains information about the address and driving license details of the driver.

The colour of the uniform as specified below.

Trouser - Black

T-Shirt - Dark Turquoise colour (specification given below)

Explanatory Note

(This does not form the part of the above notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport)

The District Auto Rickshaw Drivers Unions Co-ordination Committee, Kochi has requested to change the color/pattern of the uniform for the drivers of auto rickshaws plying as feeder service to Public Transport System of Kochi mainly, Metro, Stage Carriages and Water Transport and they have proposed a pattern for consideration. The Director (Projects) of KMRL, Kochi has recommended for favourable consideration of the request of District Auto Rickshaw Drivers Unions Co-ordination Committee, Kochi. The Transport Commissioner has examined the matter in detail and find out the said change in uniform pattern is intended to specially identify the feeder Auto Rickshaw Drivers and to induce a better, safe and secured feeling to the traveling public, especially for women, senior citizen and children and also make the Auto Rickshaw drivers more responsible in terms of driving and exhibiting good behaviour with the passengers, and decided to issued the notifications concerned accordingly.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.
